- 1. If you have not enrolled your child(ren), please use the form "Application Form Re-Enrollment."
- 2. STUDENTS WHO DO NOT HAVE AN UPDATED IMMUNIZATION FORM OR WHO HAVE NOT CONTIENTIOUSLY OBJECTED <u>WILL</u> <u>NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND SCHOOL BY MONDAY, OCTOBER 14</u>. The immunization forms are located on the website. Choose the appropriate form by grade. Feel free to contact our school nurse, Mrs. Beth Reilly at <u>beth.reilly@district196.org</u> with any questions.
- 3. STUDENTS WHO ARE INVOLVED IN ATHLETICS WHO HAVE NOT HAD A PHYSICAL IN THE LAST 3 YEARS MUST HAVE A PHYSICAL FORM ON FILE. ATHLETES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY IN ANY GAMES IF THIS FORM IS NOT ON FILE. If you have a son or daughter playing sports who has not had a physical in the last three years, please use the "Sports Physical Examination Form." As an option, physicals cost \$25 and are provided by Dr. Justin Hoff, a chiropractor in Rosemount. He is located at 14450 S. Robert Trail, #208. His number is 651.423.2251. Please reference that you would like an athletic physical, and it is for First Baptist School.
- Please download the "Emergency Contact Form Elementary" for K3 through 5<sup>th</sup> grade, and use "Emergency Contact Form Secondary" for 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade. Please turn this into the school office. You will be contacted if these forms are not turned in. They are used in case of an emergency.
- To purchase school supplies, use "Supply List Elementary" for K3 through 5<sup>th</sup> grade and use "Supply List Secondary" for the 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- 6. To update and/or purchase uniforms for your son or daughter, the information is provided on the website and are in the list of documents starting with the word "Uniform." There are several documents as they relate to elementary or secondary.
- 7. Please read the "Welcome Letter 2019-2020 School Year." It contains some important information as well.
- 8. Please mark Thursday, August 22 at 7 p.m. on your calendar. YOU WILL NOT WANT TO MISS the Parent Orientation and Open House! Bring the whole family. Here are some of the highlights:
