## Observation and exposition

- 1. Read the passage [SLIDES]
- 2. Observation and exposition
  - a. The time and setting [SLIDES]
    - i. Distances
      - 1. Approximately 50-60 miles from Thessalonica to Berea
    - ii. Berea
      - 1. The capital and principal city of the province of Macedonia
      - 2. Surrendered to the Romans in 168 B.C.
      - 3. Possibly mentioned in an ancient text dating 432 B.C.
      - 4. Not on the Via Egnatia
        - a. Was Paul heading for Rome? Did Claudius deter his plans?
      - 5. Modern-day Veria
  - b. Paul, Silas, and Timothy(?) leave Thessalonica and go to Berea (10)
  - c. They go to the synagogue and preach the word (10-11)
    - i. His message content same or similar to what he proclaimed in Thessalonica?
      - 1. The Christ (Messiah) had to suffer (die) and rise from the dead
      - 2. Jesus his life, ministry, death, resurrection
      - 3. Jesus is the Christ
  - d. The response of the Bereans (11-12)
    - i. They were noble (open-minded)
    - ii. They received the word with eagerness
    - iii. They examined the Scriptures daily to see if Paul spoke the truth
      - 1. John Brown quote
      - 2. The Scriptures and letter writing in the first century
        - a. Were the Scriptures readily available?

- c. Colossians 4:16
- d. Paul may have had copies of Galatians with him

## e. Paul's response?

- i. We're not told, but surely it was positive. Was he insulted that they checked the Scriptures to verify what he said?
- f. The Jews from Thessalonica follow and keep harassing Paul and the word (13)
- g. Paul leaves for Athens (14-15)
- h. Map out and talk through Paul, Silas, and Timothy's travels in Macedonia and Achaia, using Acts and 1 Thessalonians
- Read 1 Thessalonians for Paul's perspective on what happened in Thessalonica, answers to some questions raised earlier, and encouragement.
  - i. Imagine you are the newly formed Thessalonian church?
