Press Release – Update on Missing Person, Joseph Camplin January 7, 2019

Joseph Camplin was reported missing to the Northfield Police Department on November 16, 2018.

On January 6, 2019, at about 2:00 p.m., the Dakota County Sheriff's Office received a report of a deceased male located in a wooded area in the 2400 block of 320th St. W. in Waterford Township. A hunter located the deceased. Northfield Investigators worked with DCSO Deputies and the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office at the scene. NAFRS firefighters also responded to assist.

Today, the Medical Examiner's Office positively identified the deceased as the missing person, Joseph Camplin. No foul play is suspected at this time.

We would like to thank Northstar Search and Rescue, the Dakota County Sheriff's Office, the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office, Minnesota BCA, and all others who helped with searches, disseminating information, and investigation.
