Once payment is received we will obtain your new MC Number, as well as, your new USDOT number and your BOC-3 the same day. In one to four business days your application will be published in the daily Federal Registry. At this point we will wait for the filing of your insurance. **Remember, the process can go no further until the insurance filing is complete and proof of payment for the Heavy Highway Vehicle Use Tax is available. Once your insurance is filed we will schedule a phone appointment to cover information specific to your base State. Following this we will begin your base State's filing requirements. The entire process takes between five and seven weeks for most States at this time. We will keep you informed, by e-mail, as we progress through each stage of the application. As always, we encourage you to call us of you have questions or concerns. Once you authority is active and you are ready a representative with Truckstop.com will contact you to set up your trial account. At this point you will have access to freight and be in business!
